A primary function of today's retrofit installer is air leakage control. Uncontrolled air leakage through the building enclosure can reduce the effectiveness of insulation increasing energy usage, introduce moisture into the building assembly and cause comfort problems for the building occupants. This course provides the foundation for the completion of successful and long lasting air sealing improvements.

Objectives:

As a result of this interactive training, participants will have the ability to:

- Produce effective and durable air sealing results.
- Complete air sealing retrofit upgrades in a cost effective and professional manner.
- Reduce the air exchange into and out of buildings.

Training Modules:

- Material selection
- Health and safety requirements
- Air leakage control strategies
- High density insulation for air sealing
- Verifying quality
